Dear Woodrow Wilson Families:

I am writing to you today with important information regarding our October 19th Hybrid opening. As part of our ongoing parent communication during remote learning, I wanted to share with you some important information and happenings at WWMS.

Hybrid Opening

As per Dr. Bragen's [letter](#) dated October 5th, we are scheduled to move to our hybrid program on October 19th, 2020. Currently, Woodrow Wilson Middle School will be returning approximately 21% of our student population as in person attendees. Therefore, WWMS in person students will be able to attend school in person on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday. All schools will be totally remote on Wednesdays to allow for mid-week deep cleaning.

Hybrid Bell Schedule

In Person v. Remote Students

In August parents were given the option to select in-person or remote instruction for their children. If you committed your child to attend in-person or chose to attend school totally remote that will remain in effect until the end of the first marking period (November 13, 2020). Should someone desire to change from in-person to remote learning they are able to do so with notice to the building principal. The district will send out a survey to parents in the next few weeks to solicit commitments for either in-person or remote instruction for the second marking period.

In Person Students

Parents of those students attending in person beginning on October 19th will receive further instructions next week regarding new procedures and protocols put in place in the building.
